



Funding Guidelines

Programs & Services: For 2022 and 2023 United Way will be primarily focused on funding to areas of greatest need in the following areas of action:

- Isolated Seniors and Elders
 - Families in Need
 - Mental Health and/or Addictions
 - Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion
1. Funding opportunities will be through an online application and volunteer granting review process.
 - a. Applications will be invited from eligible charities based in the Capital Regional District (CRD) who are responding to needs in the community.
 - b. An agency can apply for **\$15,000 to \$50,000 per program.**
 - c. An agency can apply for one program only.
 2. Timelines for funding: March 31, 2022, through April 1, 2023:
 - a. Applications will be reviewed by UWSVI following the close of the funding call on February 1, 2022.
 - b. Funding decisions will be made through a rigorous Community Impact volunteer and Board approved granting review process.
 - c. Memorandums of Understanding (MOU's) will be provided following Board approval in March 2022.
 - d. Funding is subject to fulfillment of reporting requirements as outlined in the MOU.
 3. Agencies will be invited to submit requests for both new and existing programs through this process, recognizing that previous programs may no longer be running and/or needs have changed due to the impacts of COVID-19.
