



## Funding Guidelines

**Programs & Services:** For 2023 and 2024 United Way will be primarily focused on funding to areas of greatest need in the following areas of action:

- Seniors and Elders
  - Families
  - Mental Health and/or Addictions
  - Diversity, Equity & Inclusion and Support for Indigenous Communities
1. Funding opportunities will be through an online application and volunteer granting review process.
    - a. Applications will be invited from eligible charities and qualified donees based in the Capital Regional District (CRD) who are responding to needs in the community.
    - b. An agency can apply for **\$15,000 to \$50,000 per program.**
    - c. An agency can apply for one program only.
  2. Timelines for funding: March 31, 2023, through April 1, 2024:
    - a. Applications will be reviewed by UWSVI following the close of the funding call on February 17, 2023.
    - b. Funding decisions will be made through a rigorous Community Impact volunteer and Board approved granting review process.
    - c. Memorandums of Understanding (MOU's) will be provided following Board approval in March 2023.
    - d. Funding is subject to fulfillment of reporting requirements as outlined in the MOU.
  3. Agencies will be invited to submit requests for both new and existing programs.
