

UWSVI 2023 COMMUNITY CAMPAIGN RAFFLE TICKET RULES

1. Eligibility

- 1.1 Participants must be at least 19 years of age to purchase and/or hold a raffle ticket.
- 1.2 Employees of UWSVI, board members, their immediate family members, and individuals residing in the same household are not eligible to participate.
- 1.3 The raffle is open to Canadian residents, excluding Quebec, only and participants must be the age of majority or older in their province or territory of residence at the time of entry.

2. Ticket Purchase

- 2.1 Raffle tickets can be purchased at specified locations or through the UWSVI official website between 11 am on September 14, 2023, and 12 p.m. on October 13, 2023. To purchase tickets through the UWSVI website, purchasers will complete an online order form. Once payment is received, tickets will be assigned manually, scanned, and emailed to the purchaser.
- 2.2 Each raffle ticket costs \$50 unless multiple tickets are purchased, in which case the price will be \$125 for three (3) tickets and \$200 for six (6) tickets.
- 2.3 Ticket purchases are non-refundable.
- 2.4 Tickets are not transferable.

No Refunds: All ticket sales are final. There will be no refunds issued to anyone for any reason. All tickets purchased and entered into the draw cannot be refunded, including if ticket purchasers made an error in selecting the amount of tickets they desire to purchase.

UWSVI is not responsible for lost or stolen tickets. All tickets, transactions, and winners associated with the raffle are subject to the rules, regulations, and procedures put in place by UWSVI and the lawful charges thereof.

3. Prize

- 3.1 The prizes for the raffle are as follows:
 - First Prize: One (1) round trip flight for two (2) guests to any regularly scheduled and marketed WestJet destination, one (1) \$500 hotel voucher, one (1) 30-min Flytographer Gift Card, and two (2) pieces of Samsonite luggage.
 - Second Prize: One (1) Dual Sport 3 Trek hybrid bike.
 - Third Prize: One (1) night at Delta Hotels Victoria Ocean Pointe Resort, two (2) tickets to The Victoria Symphony, and one (1) \$25 gift card to Pagliacci's.
 - Early Bird Prize: One (1) night at The Fairmont Empress Hotel.
- 3.2 Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable for cash or other forms.

4. Drawing



4.1 The early bird raffle drawing will be held on September 29, 2023, at 12 p.m. at the UWSVI office (201-633 Courtney Street, Victoria BC, V8W 1B9). The main prize raffle drawing will be held on October 13, 2023, at 12 p.m. at the UWSVI office (201-633 Courtney Street, Victoria BC, V8W 1B9).

4.2 Winners do not need to be present to win.

4.3 Winners will be notified via phone and email within one week of the drawing.

5. Claiming the Prize

5.1 Winners must present valid identification and the winning ticket to claim their prize.

5.2 Winners must claim their prize at the UWSVI office (201-633 Courtney Street, Victoria BC, V8W 1B9) within 30 days of the drawing date.

5.3 Unclaimed prizes will be forfeited after the specified time period and a new winner will be drawn.

5.4 If a situation occurs that causes a delay or prevents the draw from happening at the identified time, a substitute draw will take place on the first possible Friday following the delay. All persons who purchased tickets will be notified of the new draw date by email and provided information to receive a refund if no new draw date is possible.

6. Liability

6.1 UWSVI is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged tickets.

6.2 By participating in the raffle, participants agree to release and hold harmless UWSVI and its representatives from any and all liability for any injuries, loss, or damage of any kind arising from or in connection with the raffle or any prize won.

7. Compliance with Laws

7.1 The raffle is conducted pursuant to British Columbia law, and all participants are bound by the applicable laws and regulations governing the raffle.

7.2 Any person attempting to defraud or in any way tamper with this raffle will be ineligible for prizes and may be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

7.3 The organizers will follow British Columbia's Personal Information Protection Act in the documenting and collection of information.
